Dear Parents and Carers,

At St Peter's, we always strive for the highest standards across all aspects of school life. After the Christmas break, we are going to have a particular focus on the standard of uniform. This is vitally important as we do not want to encourage an environment where pupils are competing in terms of appearance, we want all pupils to wear our uniform with pride and adhere to the uniform and appearance expectations.

As a result of this, I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents and carers of the expectations we have in school regarding this:

- Pupils are not permitted to wear any jewellery in school, including rings, bracelets and necklaces, staff will ask for this to be removed, and this will be confiscated for the day.
- No piercings of any type are permitted, including clear earrings/studs. Again, these will be confiscated if worn on school site.
- Pupils are not permitted to wear false eyelashes, false nails, nail varnish or excessive make up. We will request that this is removed.
- All footwear must be formal, leather black shoes. Any type of trainer or sports branded footwear is not permitted. Pupils will be offered shoes to lend if trainers are worn to school.
- Blazers must be worn at all times whilst on school site, unless given specific permission not to while in lessons or in extreme hot weather. School jumpers are always optional.
- All pupils must wear a school tie, unless wearing summer uniform (only September-October half term and Easter onwards). Pupils will need to hand in a mobile phone to borrow a tie each day they do not have their own until a new one has been purchased.
